DPRK	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• (GOV/OR.1189 – Para 93) ...Cuba, speaking on behalf of NAM, stressed the Movement's principles and priorities on disarmament and international security as adopted at the 14th Summit Conference of Heads of State or Government of NAM, held in Cuba on 11–16 September 2006.• (GOV/OR.1189 – Para 94) She reiterated NAM's desire for the total denuclearization of the Korean Peninsula and its continued support for the six-party talks as a means of finding a long term solution to the Korean nuclear issue through diplomacy and dialogue. Consequently, NAM had welcomed the six-party joint statement and subsequently the agreement on the initial actions for its implementation, adopted in Beijing on 13 February 2007.• (GOV/OR.1189 – Para 95) NAM noted with satisfaction that an Agency team headed by the Deputy Director General for Safeguards had visited the DPRK, at the Government's invitation, on 26–29 June 2007. NAM welcomed the understanding reached between the Agency and the DPRK during that visit, as reflected in paragraph 5 of the Director General's report contained in document GOV/2007/36. In that regard, NAM emphasized that the Agency was the sole competent international authority on nuclear verification issues.
